Investec Property+ are geared financial instruments listed by Investec Bank Limited ('Investec') that are traded on the Equity Market of the JSE ('exchange') and can be purchased through any stockbroker.



- Long-term leveraged exposure to the listed property sector
- Investors pay a fraction of the underlying security price upfron and receive the full benefit of distributions and share price growth
- Investors make a final payment and acquire the underlying security
 - No margin calls or further payment obligations
- Liquidity is provided by Invested
- Distributions can reduce the final payment to R0.01
- Potential losses are limited to the initial investment
- There are potential tax advantages
- The security is issued by Investec and listed on the JSE

What are Invested Property+?

Investec Property+ are European call warrants issued by Investec, under its Warrant and Note Programme. They give you the right - but not the obligation - to buy, in two steps, an underlying security from Investec at a floating strike price on the expiry date.



You make an initial payment to buy the Investec Property+. On the date of issue, the price of the Investec Property+ will be about 55% of the price of the underlying security.



You may, but are not obliged to, make a final payment on the expiry date to acquire the underlying security. This is a floating amount and varies during the term of the Investec Property+. This is also referred to as the exercise price.

Your choices at maturity

On maturity of the investment, you may:



make the final payment
(exercise price) and receive the
underlying securities.



do nothing and let Investec

Property+ expire.

Exercise price calculation

The exercise price is a floating amount that varies throughout the term of the Investec Property+. It is initially set on the issue date but recalculates on a daily basis in accordance with the above formula.

EP = PEP x

1+ Rate 365

EP = the exercise price on a given day

PEP = the exercise price on the previous day

D = the sum of all distributions which have an ex-distribution date on that day

Rate = the base rate plus the margin, expressed as a decimal





Risks

Since Investec Property+ provides geared exposure to the underlying securities, the risks of investing in Investec Property+ are greater than those of investing a similar amount directly in the underlying securities.
