The Investec Top 40 Supertracker ("Supertracker") is a structured product issued by Investec Bank Limited ("IBL") and listed on the JSE Limited ("JSE").

The Supertracker is a 3.5-year structured product linked to the performance of the FTSE/JSE Top 40 Index ("the Index"). The Supertracker is designed to provide investors with a geared return to the Index over the investment term, and it provides geared exposure with a high degree of capital protection.

Investors have a potential to earn a geared return of 1.5x the positive performance of the Index to a cap of 35%, maximum return is therefore $1.5 \times 35\% = 52.50\%$.


