• Indemnities:

17.5 – The Intermediary further indemnifies Investec against any claim against it by a Client and/or any third party arising from (i) the Intermediary's internal processes, including, but not limited to, regulatory, compliance or other conduct and risk management processes, and (ii) the Intermediary providing Investec with any information received from the Client for whatever reason. These changes will come into effect on the 25th of March 2023.
